## Guidelines to Contributors

1. The Journal will publish Research papers, Articles and Communications containing research work as well as reviews from authors.
2. Manuscripts of paper in duplicate should be type written in double space on one side of the bond paper or in CD form.
3. The paper should not have been published or communicated for publication else where. Authors are solely responsible for the factual accuracy of their contribution. The data reported in the paper should not be older than 5 years. Paper should be divided into following sub-heading -
  - (a) **Title** with authors name and address.
  - (b) **Abstract** should indicate the principal findings. It should not be more than 250 words.
  - (c) **Key words** : key words in italics should not exceed 4 or 5 words.
  - (d) **Introduction** : should be brief and without headings. It should relate to the aim of the study.
  - (e) **Materials and methods** : when methods are well known citation of the standard work is sufficient. All measurements should be in metric units.
  - (f) **Results and Discussion** : The results should be supported by brief and adequate tables, graphs, charts and photographs wherever needed.
  - (g) **Tables and figures** : should be given on separate papers. Data can be given either in figures or tables but not in both. Figures, illustrations or photographs should be of good quality and suitable for final reduction allowing space for legends.
  - (h) **References** : should be arranged alphabetically without serial numbers as illustrated below :-
